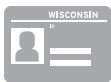


THERE ARE COUNTLESS WAYS TO BE COUNTED.

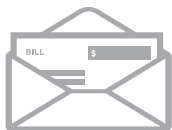

GET A FREE WI STATE ID CARD. AND VOTE.

Most people already have the photo ID they need to vote in the next election. But if you don't, now you can get a Wisconsin state ID card for free. Yes, free. Just bring a few documents—like your certified birth certificate, Social Security card and a utility bill, for example—to your local Division of Motor Vehicles. If you don't have a birth certificate or other documents, the DMV can still help you get a free ID for voting. Get your free ID today, and remember to bring it when you vote.
